Bryan Wolfenberger – Cal State Bakersfield

Bryan has seen significant time as a forward having played in 10 (started 2) of Bakersfields' 11 matches.

Keegan Fraschieri – Chico State

Keegan has played in six of nine Wildcat (3-4-2) matches. He scored the game-winner, Sept. 28 against Stanislaus, vaulting the Wildcats into a tie for first in the CCAA-North Division.
