U-9 League Results

We are very excited about the potential in our youngest players. This year we implemented a new training model that we call "Catalyst". The idea is to focus on the technical aspects of the game and expose roughly 40 players to some of the best coaches in the area in a fun small group, game filled atmosphere. The results indicate that it has worked, winning league while scoring 40 goals and giving up only 5 in 10 games! We are continuing to train and coaches, Jovan Milojevich, Jason Wescott, and Todd Higley are looking forward to more successes in 2007!

U-10 League Results

Ballistic United, coached by Bert Wilkinson started strong and never looked back. Going 9-1-0 in league and winning their 1st five games. Winning league and outscoring their opponents 42-9 this team is a tight and cohesive group that will never give up! Playing a determined Union City Barcelona, for first place, on the mud and waterlogged field of Sports Park tied 0-0 with less than 5 minutes to go... U-11 League Results

Coach Sean Lemoine and the Ballistic United U-11's finished the Ballistic sweep of the District 3 Al; Caffodio league by outscoring their opponents 27-14 and amassing a 7-1-2 record to take 1st place!
