2009 Jamboree Rules
U9- U10 Boys
Premier, Gold, Silver, Bronze, or D1 and D3 Teams

The Jamboree will be played in accordance with the rules of the FIFA, US Club, and modified by the following changes and additions,

CREDENTIALS:

2009 US Club passes, or USYS (with Insurance documents) player and coaches passes (properly validated by district registrar), Medical release forms are required and for all players. Player passes, coaches passes, medical releases and Player Rosters will be checked and validated at headquarters prior to the team's first match.

TOURNAMENT CHECK-IN:

Headquarters for each age group is located at the north end of Sport Park field #8 (the field of play). Each team **MUST** be checked into headquarters at least **ONE HOUR** prior to its first scheduled game.

GAME FORMAT & AWARDS

Teams will be grouped by age (pure) and by division, making four playing groups.

- U9 Division I, Premier, Gold or Silver,
- U9 Division III or Bronze
- U10 Division I, Premier, Gold, or Silver
- U10 Division III, or Bronze.

All games will consist of two 22-minute halves with a five-minute halftime break.

Referees will be instructed not to add additional time for any reason.

All games will be played 8 vs. 8.

No scores or standings will be kept.

No Player may play on more than one team

The first team listed on the schedule is the home team. The home team will provide the game ball. If there is a conflict in team colors, the home team must change jerseys.

All participants will receive a Tournament Pin. No trophies or medals will be awarded..

No protests will be allowed.

All teams will play four games over the two-day Jamboree.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Unlimited

- a. Prior to throw-in by either team.
- b. Prior to goal kick by either team.
- c. After a goal is scored by either team.
- d. Prior to resumption of play after an injury each team may substitute one for one.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Limited

- a. A player **MUST** be substituted following a yellow card. The player may return at the next substitution opportunity.
- b. Substitutes must notify the referee and wait for his/her signal before entering the field at midfield.

All games are intended to start at the scheduled time. If a team has not taken the field with a minimum of six players at the scheduled time, the game will be forfeited to the team present.

Goal Kicks can be taken from anywhere in the Penalty Box area.

Red Cards: If a player or coach is ejected from a game, he/she is automatically suspended from the team's next game. Violent red card ejections will result in suspension from the remainder of the jamboree. Fighting and use of profanity by the players and harassment of referees by coaches and /or parents will not be tolerated.

Alcoholic Beverages/Controlled Substances/Smoking:

Possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages and/or controlled substances are expressly prohibited at all of the field complexes. Any team (including players, coaches, parents and spectators) found violating this rule will be asked to leave the field, and face possible expulsion from the tournament. All persons will be expected to refrain from smoking at the field sites.

Sportsmanship and Conduct:

Good sportsmanship and "respectful" conduct are expected to prevail at all times. Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their players, parents and spectators. Coaches will ensure that referees officiating their games are treated with courtesy and respect.

The Jamboree committee will resolve any situation not covered by these rules.

NOTE:

CYSA, Cal-North teams applying for the BUSC Fall Harvest Jamboree with USYS passes. USYS teams **WILL NOT** be covered by CYSA insurance, **but your team can still apply and Play.**

It takes a little extra time to obtain insurance, and up to two weeks to sign up a team for US Club membership, This can be done over the WEB, with a filled in team roster and Player birth certificates faxed to U.S. Club for certification. U.S. Club is located in North Carolina, a three-hour time zone difference. Coaches and Managers PLEASE plan ahead.
